All members whether player, parent, coach, umpire, spectator, or committee member of the Diamonds Netball Club are reminded of their expectation and commitment to uphold the Club's Code of Conduct, as well as the Success Netball Association Code of Conduct.

Our Codes of Conduct are underpinned by the following core values:

- To act within the rules and spirit of netball.
- To display respect and courtesy towards everyone involved in netball.
- To prioritise the safety and well-being of all our players and members.

BREACH

Any alleged breach of our code of conduct will be managed using the process outlined below.

Offence 1 – A meeting will be organised with the parents/adult player, the coach and a club representative, discussing the incident and the planned course of action. A written warning will be sent.

Offence 2 – A written final warning will be sent.

Offence 3 – The matter will go before a tribunal. A suspension or ban will be issued depending on the nature of the offence.

Any form of physical abuse will be escalated directly to a tribunal with a consequence of suspension or possible ban.
